Quarantine for 5 days and wear a mask around others for an additional 5 days (masking is for age 2 and over). Do not travel for 10 days.

There is no need for your child to quarantine, but they must wear a mask for 10 days after exposure, and get a PCR test on day 5, and test again if any symptoms develop.

Quarantine for 5 days and if symptoms have improved wear a mask around others for an additional 5 days (masking is for age 2 and over). Do not travel for 10 days from onset of symptoms.

▼
Yes

Isolate for 5 days and if symptoms have improved wear a mask around others for an additional 5 days (masking is for age 2 and over). Do not travel for 10 days from onset of symptoms.

Note: If anyone in your household tests positive, each member needs to quarantine according to the above guidelines.

**For testing sites, Google "COVID testing Lee County."
If you use a home test that is positive, you should get a rapid or PCR test for confirmation.
